Duration:

40 minutes (introduction, exercise, brainstorming)

Aim:

Get to know the basic steps of planning process Get to know the meaning of the SWOT analysis and try to thing broadly Type of activity:

SWOT analysis through worksheet

Group number:

group of 4 people individual

Recommended age: 17-22

Instructions:

For the educator:

With participants talk about SWOT analysis – how it works, how to use it etc.
The educator decides how to work – with groups or individuals – we recommend groups.
Prepared worksheets – printed or virtual; worksheet could be transfer into other online useful tools

For the user/interested participants:

- 1. Read prepared articles to acquire some new knowledge on planning process.
- 2. One of the most important tools in the planning and decision-making process is SWOT analysis. SWOT analysis is a simple but useful framework for analyzing your organization's strengths, weaknesses, opportunities, and threats.

Read The facts and tips (part of the activity 2), which is about old boiling room renovation and try to make the SWOT analysis.
