Case study of the EcoPlum social enterprise

- EcoPlum is an example of an eco-friendly business. - The customers earn green shopping rewards points, known as EcoChipz, good for coupons in the shop or donations to environmental causes EcoPlum supports.

- Ask the students the questions below and collect several answers:
 - What are the benefits that a company like this brings to society? (Preserving natural resources, care for the labor force conditions, consumers' health protection etc.)
 - What kind of obstacles do you think they encounter? (Consumer mentality, higher costs, etc.)
