

Using artsandculture.google.com you could make a visit to one of the many museums this site offers. It would be much more interesting for students to learn about famous paintings, sculptures, artists, art history and different styles by taking VR tours in one of the museums.

### **BACKGROUND:**

Although in some cities there is the possibility to visit the museum with the school, this site gives the possibility to everyone, no matter where you are. You could visit museums in different parts of the world from your classroom. In this way students will be motivated to learn and explore more than they are when they listen to lectures where they can only see a few pictures and hear a lot of information.

<u>Collaborative Process:</u> It is possible to do the group visit of museum with help of projector or smartboard in classroom.


